

## **BMFA Scotland Area Members' Meeting**

**Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2025, via Zoom**

1. Apologies for absence

2. Club attendance and establishing voting strength

3. Minutes of previous meeting held on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> November 2024

a. The previous minutes had been missed by some members due to the location being at the end of the AGM minutes, other members had the emails going into their junk, whilst others were asked to register with Microsoft to view the minutes. Alison stated that BMFA HQ are aware of the issue and were trying to get it sorted.

b. Alison read the minutes out, whilst Mark posted them into the chat line.

4. Matters arising from minutes:

c. D. Bouchard re SAA Training and Testing now resolved.

d. Andy Pirie resigned as Achievement Scheme Co-ordinator. Bill Anderson has stepped in.

e. SAA has agreed to joint Training and Testing events.

f. It was made clear that individual clubs are required to invite BMFA examiners formally to their field for testing, the BMFA examiners cannot "invite themselves". 4 clubs have said yes to a joint BMFA/SAA session. It was agreed that the offer of paying 50% of the day fee (£75) should be offered.

g. Falkirk Club had got back to Alasdair Sutherland regards to a fly-in, stating that it would be raised with members at the AGM in November 2025.

Proposed: David Bouchard (East Fortune)

Seconded: Douglas Cowan (Warrix)

Minutes accepted by majority of members.

5. Reports from officers

a. Chairman, Alasdair Sutherland

The BMFA gazebo is available to any club that requires it. It is being housed at present at the Clyde Valley Flyers.

Alasdair asked to clubs to think about events that could be held to promote the BMFA in Scotland.

The ratification of examiners process had changed. Alasdair reminded clubs should contact the BMFA head office direct as they should not go through the Achievement Scheme Co-ordinator, Bill Anderson.

It was also noted that every year it is the club's duty to ratify their club's examiners so that the list at the BMFA can remain current.

b. Treasurer, Mark Christie

Nothing to report apart from balance sits at £3,159.96

c. Secretary, Alison Hicks

Alison stated that she was settling in to the post but there are still a few hiccups with technology or procedures. She is also hoping to get some help from Andy Symons regarding the Scottish Area webpages on the BMFA portal.

She noted that we had received the minutes of the board meeting of the SAME and these should be available on the website.

The previous minutes of the Scottish area have been archived at the BMFA. However, there is an issue with members access to these as it appears that you need to sign in to Microsoft. This has been raised with BMFA head office and is being resolved.

There have been a few enquiries about possible training and testing days and also one grant enquiry from SW Flyers.

Finally, Alison wanted to thank the rest of the committee for their help and assistance whilst she settles in.

d. Area Delegate to BMFA, Iain Nichol

Nothing to report, except Club of the Year was taking place tonight.

e. Achievement Scheme Co-ordinator, Bill Anderson

Bill noted that there are only 8 BMFA examiners distributed through the 26 BMFA affiliated clubs. No examiners within Fife.

He requested that Alasdair Sutherland write to the clubs requesting members who might wish to become examiners to come forward.

The BMFA would like 2 examiners per club, in an ideal world.

The new test forms are on the website.

Derek Allison and David Fisher are fixed wing examiners, both at Warrix.

f. Drone Representative, Michael Williamson

Nothing to report

g. Country Member Representative

No report as the post is vacant.

During the meeting Ken Ward was co-opted as CMR until AGM 2025 when the post will need to be formally voted in.

6. Elections for vacant posts

a. Vice-chairman – remained empty

b. Flying Disciplines Representative – remained empty

c. Country Member Representative

Ken stated he was happy to step in as representative. He flies around Perth area and uses drones for photography and archaeology.

Ken was voted into the position by David Storey (Clyde Vally Flyers) and seconded by Mark McDowel (Ayr and District)

d. Outreach Officer – remained empty

There was a discussion about the BMFA Central Outreach Officer has a budget of £5,000 to raise awareness of model flying and to facilitate weight lifting competition.

This post would be a benefit to all clubs as it could generate new members amongst the younger generations in particular. Groups such as air cadets, school, universities etc should be encouraged to visit clubs. The BMFA Scottish Area funding could be available to aid cash flow of clubs and fund matched from the main BMFA outreach fund.

## 7. Any other business

Mark Christie announced that he is stepping down as Treasurer and therefore a replacement will be needed.

Alex Kennedy (Warrix) asked about the number of members in Scotland.

Alasdair Sutherland said there were around 800. The number is a little ambiguous due to the groupings – there are 388 whose main club is BMFA affiliated.

Mark Christie raised the budget spend. Funds are to be spent aligned to how they were requested from BMFA in the annual grant application.

Alasdair Sutherland broke down spending as per headings.

Elgin happy to host an event.

Iain Nichol asked what happens to any unspent funds at the end of the financial year. Alasdair Sutherland stated that any funds remaining will be offset from the next round of funding.

A general discussion was had about promoting the BMFA at the Ayr Airshow (5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> September 2025). It was decided that the cost of a pitch and preparation required might be too much for this year but it should be looked into for next year. Douglas Cowan (Warrix) said he would try and find out who Alasdair Sutherland could contact. John Lang (Blackridge and District) shared a link about the Ayr Air show in the message tab.

Bill Anderson said that could the Angus club contact him directly about examining a member who wants to become an examiner. He said that it should be done on a separate weekend to the Training and Testing Weekend.

Bill Anderson also raised a concern about how the funding of an T and T event would be done with regards to the 50:50 split with the SAA if for example no BMFA members turn up on the day to be tested. Alasdair Sutherland stated he would look into the details.

Note: In section 4.f. above, the offer to pay 50% of Training and Testing Day fee (£75) was agreed but it was not ratified as no vote by club delegates took place. To allow the Scotland Area Committee to pay out 50% of the Training and Testing Day field cost to hosting clubs the affiliated clubs are required to vote and pass the resolution.

24 June 2025

Mark Christie noted that in the Constitution these meetings should be aligned with area delegates meetings so that we can receive feedback for the area delegate and vote for the next area delegate items.

It was agreed to hold off proposing a September date.
